

Ice Cream Cones

Materials List

Skill Level: Confident Beginner - To have a successful experience in this class, you must have some experience with machine sewing, measuring, and cutting fabric.

Size: Original Pattern size: 46"X56" However, this class will cover the instructions for making the ice cream cone blocks. The goal is to make at least 4 blocks to create a wall hanging/table topper that is approximately 30"X30" **NOTE:** Cone blocks can also be sewn into a runner that will measure approximately 52" long X 16" wide.



Skills learned in this class

- Use an acrylic template ruler
- Optional Quilt finishing with embroidery floss ties and/or small buttons

Purchase the Template Ruler: 6" Curvy Log Cabin Trim Tool

	Topper Size (30" X 30")	Lap Size (46" X 46")
Fat Quarters in Yummy Colors	4 FQ	Refer to Original Pattern
Background Fabric: White	¼ yard	Refer to Original Pattern
Cone Fabric: brown/tan/khaki	¼ yard	Refer to Original Pattern
Border fabric	¼ yard	Refer to Original Pattern
Backing Fabric	1 yard	Refer to Original Pattern
Batting	Craft size or 36" X 36" scrap	Refer to Original Pattern
Binding if quilting is desired	¼ yard	Refer to Original Pattern

Materials (Finishing)

- Hand-tying
 - Embroidery Floss in colors to enhance ice cream colors and background. Whimsical buttons or other embellishments
 - Sewing and Embroidery needles
 - If using buttons or other embellishments as decoration, check that the needle will go through the holes on the items
- Other Quilting Options
 - Use your favorite quilting method

Supplies

- Cut Loose Press Pattern: *Ice Cream Cones* - Available at Blackstone Quilting Co.
- Creative Grids 6" Curvy Log Cabin Trim Tool - Available at Blackstone Quilting Co.
- Sewing machine - test for proper working order before class
 - General sewing foot or 1/4" foot
- Neutral and/or coordinating thread for sewing
- Optional: Coordinating thread for machine quilting
- Bobbins: At least (2) Full Bobbins
- Fabric Scissors
- Fabric Pins or Fabric Clips
- Seam ripper
- Cutting mat and Rotary Cutter [Cutting mats are available in the classroom if needed.]
- Suggested additional Acrylic Rulers: 6" X 24" for cutting strips
- Suggested Additional Acrylic Ruler: small acrylic ruler for cutting sewn pieces apart.
- OPTIONAL: Best Press® spray starch and sizing
 - Using Best Press® on your project in various stages will provide a crisp look to the finished project.

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

- Iron all fabric BEFORE cutting - use Best Press® spray (optional) to provide some additional stability to the fabric

CUTTING	Topper Size (30" X 30")	Lap Size (46" X 46")
Fat Quarters in Yummy Colors	Cut (4) 1 3/4" X Width of Fat Quarter (FQ; (approx 22") strips FROM EACH COLOR	Refer to Original Pattern
Background Fabric: White	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cut (1) 1 1/2" X Width of FQ; sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" X 1 1/2" center squares ● Cut (4) 1 3/4" X WOF for Wide strips ● Cut (8) 1 1/4" X WOF for Narrow strips 	Refer to Original Pattern

Cone Fabric: brown/tan/khaki	Cut (4) 1 ¼" X WOF	Refer to Original Pattern
Border fabric	Cut (3) 2 ¼" X Width of Fabric	Refer to Original Pattern
Backing Fabric	Cut to the size of the finished top	Refer to Original Pattern
Batting	Cut to the size of the finished top	Refer to Original Pattern
Binding if desired	Cut (3) 2 ¼" X WOF strips
