Joy of Zippers Workshop - Quilt Block Pillow

Materials List

Skill Level: Confident Beginner - To have a successful experience in this class, you must have some

experience with machine sewing, measuring, and cutting fabric.

Size: Varies by quilt block size

Description: Get those leftover or "oops" blocks out of your scrap bins!!! Let's make pillows with them!! Using a coordinating zipper, we will make a zipper opening rather than an envelope opening to insert the pillow form. The goal for this workshop is to complete one zippered pillow cover. However, this workshop is scheduled for 3 hours. Feel free to bring extra materials to make a second (or third) cover if there is time remaining.



Skills learned in this class

- Insert a zipper
- Make a zippered pillow cover

Also, there is pre-class prep needed for this class. See Below.

Materials

Size	12" Pillow	14" Pillow	16" Pillow
Pillow Form Size (Poly-fill not foam)	12"	14"	16"
Zipper Size (coordinating color - it will be visible)	At least 14"	At least 16"	At least 18"
Quilt Block Size (Note 1)	12 ½" square	14 ½" square	16 ½" square
Backing (Note 2)	12 ½" square	14 ½" square	16 ½" square
Zipper end tabs - same for all sizes	3" x 12" scrap fabric	3" x 12" scrap fabric	3" x 12" scrap fabric

Note 1: If the quilt block is not the size needed for the pillow, add coordinating or scrappy borders to the quilt block to enlarge the block to the size needed.

Note 2: A scrappy backing can be used if desired. Sew scraps together then trim to the required backing size.

Supplies

- Sewing machine test for proper working order before class; remember to pack your cord and foot pedal.
 - Satin Stitch foot (general sewing foot) or ¼" foot
 - Zipper Foot
 - Note that some of the newer sewing machines have a multipurpose foot that can be used for zippers. Check your machine's manual for the proper presser foot selection.
- Neutral and/or coordinating thread for sewing
- Bobbins: At least (2) Full Bobbins
- Fabric Scissors to cut the zipper tabs
- General purpose scissors to trim the zipper
- Fabric Pins or Fabric Clips
- Seam ripper
- OPTIONAL: Best Press ® spray starch and sizing (Available at Blackstone)
 - Using Best Press ® on your project in various stages will provide a crisp look to the finished project.

Please consider purchasing your materials and supplies from Blackstone Quilting Co.

Pre-Class Preparation

- Iron all fabric use Best Press ® (optional) to provide some additional stability to the fabric
- This is a workshop for learning zippers. We will not be making quilt blocks in this class. Please have your quilt block and backing trimmed to the appropriate size before class.
