

Wonky Waves Table Runner

Materials List

Instructor: Pamela Pereira - **Pattern Design/instructions by:** Pamela Pereira

Skill Level: Confident Beginner - To have a successful experience in this class, you must have some experience with machine sewing, measuring, and cutting fabric.

Size: Approximately 15" X 36 (There will be enough material to extend the runner by one additional quilt block which will make the runner approximately 15" X 46".)

The 10" Wonky Log Cabin Trim Tool is required for this project. There are a few uses for this trim tool and I will provide some additional samples during class.



Skills learned in this class

- Use an acrylic template ruler
- Use a walking foot to quilt with your sewing machine

Also, there is pre-class prep needed for this class. Please see the bottom of this materials list.

Materials

- Quilt Square Fabrics and Borders
 - Red: ½ yard
 - White: ½ yard
 - Blue: ½ yard
- Backing
 - Color of Choice: ½ yard
- Binding
 - Color of Choice: ¼ yard
- Batting - This can be purchased before the second class.
 - Thin/light weight: large enough for a 15" X 36" (or 46") long runner

Supplies

- Creative Grids 10" Wonky Log Cabin Trim Tool - available at Blackstone Quilting Co.
- Sewing machine - test for proper working order before class
 - Satin Stitch foot (general sewing foot) or ¼" foot
 - Walking Foot for quilting the runner
 - *Note: If you would like to try free motion quilting in class two, you must purchase a Free Motion quilting foot or Darning Foot. These are specialty feet specifically designed for your machine. They can cost between \$20-\$50. I recommend purchasing this type of foot from a reputable sewing machine supply store and not the internet.*
- Neutral and/or coordinating thread for sewing
- Coordinating thread for quilting
- Bobbins: At least (2) Full Bobbin(s)
- Fabric Scissors
- Pins or Fabric Clips

- Seam ripper
- Cutting mat and Rotary Cutter
- Suggested Acrylic Rulers: 6" X 24"; 5" x 5"; or 3 ½" X 12 ½"
- OPTIONAL: Best Press ® spray starch and sizing (Available at Blackstone)
 - Using Best Press ® on your project in various stages will provide a crisp look to the finished project.

Please consider purchasing your materials and supplies from Blackstone Quilting Co.

Pre-Class Preparation

- Iron all fabric BEFORE cutting - use Best Press ® (optional) to provide some additional stability to the fabric
- Cutting:
 - NOTE: DO NOT cut/sub cut strips as directed on the Wonky Trim Tool - we will be chain stitching the strips for this quilt block and the order of the colors will be different from what is noted on the ruler instructions.
 - Cut strips:
 - Red: Cut (4) 2 ½" strips by width of fabric (WOF)
 - White: Cut (4) 2 ½" strips by WOF
 - Blue: Cut (4) 2 ½" strips by WOF
