

Scrappy Sunflowers: Create Beautiful Blooms from Fabric Leftovers

Class Description:

Turn your fabric scraps into something sunny and stunning! In this hands-on class, you'll learn how to make a trio of cheerful sunflowers using nothing but leftover fabric, basic sewing supplies, and a whole lot of creativity. We'll walk you through simple techniques for assembling your flowers into a charming set that's perfect for display, gifting, or adding a little handmade joy to your space. No two flowers will be alike—just like in nature!

Materials You'll Need To Bring:

- Scrap strips of fabric minimum length 10"(This is for the petal of the flower and will be torn or pinked)
- Scrap fabric for the center of the flower (5" square are perfect)
- Scissors
- Thread and needle
- Heat-n- Bond (Small piece) or Aleene's Tacky Glue
- Pinking scissors or pinking rotary cutter blade
- Scrap Batting

Materials Provided Include:

- Dowel
- Mason Jar Cover and Ring

Perfect for beginners and seasoned stitchers alike—if you've got scraps, you've got what it takes to grow your own handmade garden!
