Guide classes are FREE classes which we offer to familiarize you with all the different facets of your machine or software, and we offer FREE instructional guide classes on all of the machines and software that we sell. You must have taken your guide classes or have a good working knowledge of your machine before you can sign up for regular classes! Bought your machine elsewhere? Classes are available for a fee!

REGISTER TODAY

Please sign up for classes at least 1 week in advance. Registration can be done by phone, in person, or online at byrnesewing.com

CLASS REGISTRATION

It is necessary to pre-register for ALL classes. You may register in-person or by phone. Payment must be made in full to assure your place in class. We need this commitment from you in order for our classes to run as smoothly as possible and so that our teachers can properly prepare for class. BE SURE AND ASK FOR YOUR SUPPLY LIST! In many cases it is necessary to do things ahead to be properly prepared for class, so be sure and check your supply list ahead of time!

REFUND POLICY

We must make our commitment to teachers one week prior to the start of their class. Therefore, refunds are available when your cancellation is made at least ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE FIRST CLASS. No exceptions. In the event that a class must be cancelled, individuals will be contacted and given a full refund.
