



**Class Name:** Boxy Pocket Pouch

**Class Description:**

Use "Stitched: Sewing Organizers" by Aneela Hoey to create this adorable boxy pouch that features handy pockets on both front and back to keep tools accessible. The interior is roomy enough to fit the small fabric boxes inside to keep everything organized.

**Required Supplies:**

- Book: Stitched Sewing Organizers by Aneela Hoey
- ½ yard cotton fabric
- 1 fat eighth cotton for zippered pocket
- ½ yard cotton lining
- 7/8 yard of 20" fusible interfacing, such as SF101
- 3/8 yard of 45" fusible fleece
- (2) Zippers (one 12" & one 6")
- 1 piece 1x2 leather or twill tape for pocket pull tab
- small handful stuffing for pincushion
- A working sewing machine/or a request to borrow one from the shop.

**Optional Supplies:**

- 1 strip ¼" x 10" double sided fusible tape for attaching zippers

**\*Notes:** anything else you'd like to mention to your students
