Catheter bag covers are for adults, so please do not use juvenile prints. Use fabric that is a subtle, solid or smaller print.

Materials:

14" x 26" fabric

(2) 18" of satin/rat tail cord for ties OR 14" of 3/8" elastic

Two Versions:

Make a casing on each 14" edge. Sew casing by folding over the edge twice approximately 1/2" each time. Sew close to the edge.

Sew sides up to the casing using a 1/2" seam.

Thread one 18" cord through each casing so that two ties stick out on each side. These will be used to tie the cover to a wheel chair or bed rail.

OR

Make a casing on the 26" edge. Thread the elastic through the casing. Sew ends of elastic together.

Sew the remaining edges with a 1/2" seam.

Rescue Pet Pillows Pattern approx. 20" x 25"

Supplies:

1 yard of fabric (for standard size pillow)
thread to match background of fabric
old pillow or pillowcase full of fabric/batting scraps (pillow insert)
fabric and batting scraps if making pillow form

1. Compute / Cut Fabric

Measure your pillow insert. Write down the length and width.

For the pillow front piece, add .5" to the length and width measurements. For example, if your pillow measures 20"x25", your Pillow Front piece should be 20.5" x 25.5"

For the pillow back piece, add 8.5" to the length and .5" to the width.

Cut your front and back pieces. Set aside the front piece.

2. Cut Back Into Two Pieces

Cut back piece 12.5" from one end.
