



**Class Name:** Christmas ornament

**Class Description:**

**This class will utilize a variety of your Christmas fabric that you are hoarding that you don't know what to do with. Scraps about 10 inches or the layer cakes work really well. These are beautiful and can be made for Christmas gifts! Think of everyone on your Christmas list that would love a handmade gift from you. We will do two different kinds and if time permits, we will work on a third one. You can do both of these ornaments with machine or finish by hand, but the foundation is done on the machine.**

**Required Supplies:**

- Variety of Christmas fabrics at least 10 inches wide or more for the one, and 18-5 inch squares for the ball.
- Thread to match
- Light weight fusible interfacing
- Hand sewing needles
- Small little bobbles for embellishing the ornaments: buttons, beads, old jewelry
- A working sewing machine/or a request to borrow one from the shop
- Standard sewing supplies: scissors, rotary cutting tools, pins/clips
