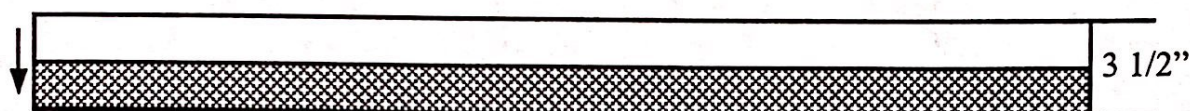


Step 1 - Undercover in Chicago

Use 1/4" seam allowances throughout the pattern. Use the 2" wide strips you have cut to piece the panels shown below.

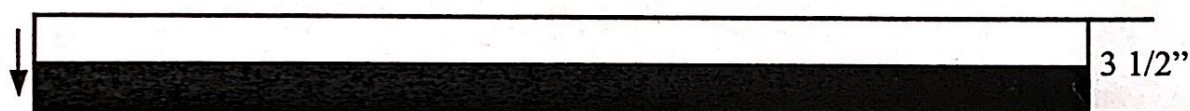
Press the seam allowances in the direction shown by the arrow at the left end of the panel. Measure your panels after pressing to check your precision. They should measure 3 1/2" wide. Adjust your seam allowance and restitch, if necessary.

Use three strips of fabric #1 and three strips of fabric #2 to make three A panels.



A - make 3 panels

Use one strip of fabric #1 and one strip of fabric #4 to make one B panel.



B - make 1 panel

Use one strip of fabric #2 and one strip of fabric #3 to make one C panel.



C - make 1 panel

Use four strips of fabric #2 and four strips of fabric #4 to piece four D panels.



D - make 4 panels
