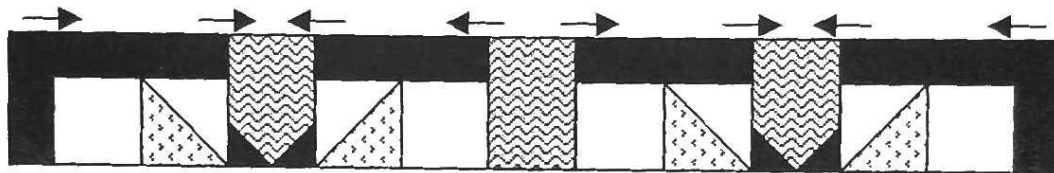


## Step 12 – Undercover in Houston VII

Make two rows like the one shown below.

Use the following pieces in this order to construct a row:  
a  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  ( $2'' \times 5''$ ) rectangle of fabric #4,  
an E unit from Step 10,  
a D unit from Step 7,  
an F unit from Step 10,  
a  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  ( $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$ ) rectangle of fabric #3,  
an E unit from Step 10,  
a D unit from Step 7,  
an F unit from Step 10, and  
a  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  ( $2'' \times 5''$ ) rectangle of fabric #4.

Press the seam allowances in the directions shown by the arrows.

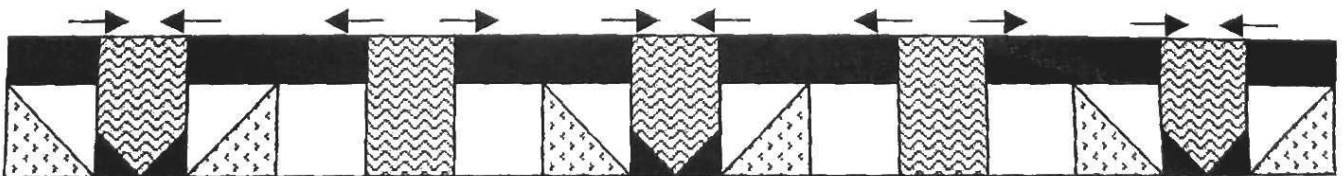

Make two rows like the one shown below.

an L unit from Step 10,  
a D unit from Step 7,  
an F unit from Step 10,  
a  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  ( $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$ ) rectangle of fabric #3,  
an E unit from Step 10,  
a D unit from Step 7,  
an F unit from Step 10,  
a  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  ( $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$ ) rectangle of fabric #3,  
an E unit from Step 10,  
a D unit from Step 7, and  
a K unit from Step 10.

Press the seam allowances in the directions shown by the arrows.
