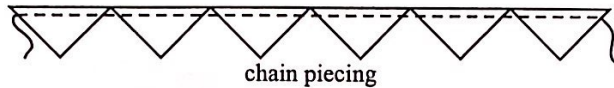
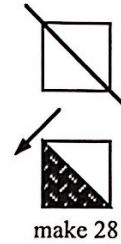


Step 2

Place a $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " square of fabric #1 on a $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " square of fabric #3, **right sides together**. Repeat to make fourteen pairs of squares.

Cut the pairs of squares once, diagonally, to make twenty-eight pairs of half-square triangles. Stitch the pairs along the diagonal to make half-square triangle units. Chain piece to save time and thread and to improve precision. Press the seam allowances toward fabric #3.

Yield: 28 units



Step 3

Cut the three $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips of fabric #4 into sixteen $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{5}{8}$ " rectangles.

Use the template below or Marti Michell's Perfect Patchwork Template C18 to cut two kite shaped pieces from each rectangle, making a total of thirty-two pieces. See the sketch for the alignment of the template on the rectangle. There should be a sliver of fabric ($\frac{1}{16}$ ") to trim at the right edge of the second kite shape.
