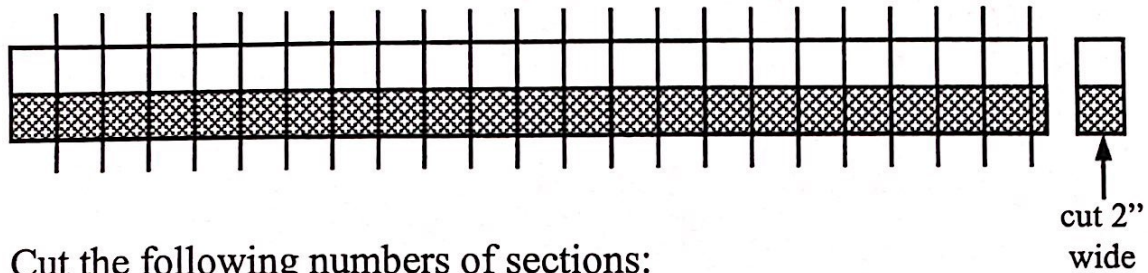


## Step 6

Crosscut the A, B, and C panels from Step 1 into sections that are 2" wide. **Do not cut the D panels!**



Cut the following numbers of sections:

A - Cut fifty-six sections.

B - Cut sixteen sections.

C - Cut fourteen sections.

Use the crosscut sections to make four patch units. Press the seam allowances to one side.



A - make 28



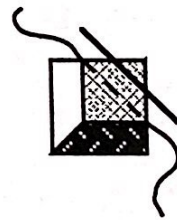
B - make 8



C - make 7

## Step 7 - Undercover in Chicago

Place a 2" square of fabric #2 on the corner of each half-square triangle unit from Step 2, right sides together. **It is important that the half-square triangle and square are positioned exactly like the diagram at the right. All units should look the like the sketch below when finished.**



Stitch on the diagonal of the 2" square as shown by the dotted line in the top sketch. Flip up the corner to check your work. If it is correct, trim away the excess as shown by the solid line, leaving 1/4" for seam allowance. Press the seam allowances toward fabric #2. Repeat to make twenty-eight sections.
