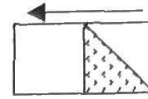


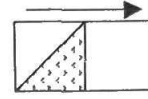
## Step 8 – Undercover in Houston VII

Sew a half-square triangle unit from Step 6 to a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ ") square of fabric #1 to make an E unit. Make sure the unit looks exactly like the one shown. Press the seam allowances toward the fabric #1 square. Repeat to make eight E units.

Use eight half-square triangle units from Step 6 and eight  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ ") squares of fabric #1 to make eight F units. Press the seam allowances toward the fabric #1 square.

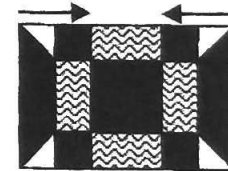
## Step 9 – Undercover in Houston VII

Sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (2") square of fabric #4 to both ends of *sixteen* units from Step 5 to make sixteen G units. Press the seam allowances toward the fabric #4 squares.

Sew the remaining units from Step 5 to two opposite sides of each Puss in the Corner block from Step 3 to make eight H units. Press the seam allowances toward the Puss in the Corner blocks.

Sew a half-square triangle unit from Step 6 to two opposite sides of a C unit from Step 7 to make an I unit. Make sure the I unit looks exactly like the one shown when completed. Press the seam allowances in the directions shown by the arrows. Repeat to make fourteen I units.

Sew a C unit from Step 7 to two opposite sides of a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ ") square of fabric #4 to make a J unit. Press the seam allowances in the directions shown by the arrows. Repeat to make seven J units.
