### **Class Description:**

Looking for a fun, portable, slow sewing project? Join Enjoli for this Collection Quilt Block of the Month and practice your needle turn applique skills. This quilt is made up of a variety of shapes all using needle turn applique. If you're just starting out, this project will give you set time to practice your skills, and have some fun with color combinations. We will work through 8 months of blocks with a month on each end for prep and finishing!

### **Required Supplies:**

- The Collection Quilt pattern from Carolyn Friedlander (refer to the pattern for listed supplies)
- A contrasting thread in 50wt for basting your shapes; a selection of 80wt thread in coordinating colors for needle turn.
- Clover Gold Eye Applique needles in size 10 (or your favorite hand work needles)
- Applique Pins
- Frixion Pen or other removable marking pen

### **Optional Supplies:**

- Mini Iron & mat for aiding in turning fabric
- Seam gauge
- Thimble or thimble pads

**\*Notes:** We will use the first month meeting to talk about color ideas, techniques and our game plan for building our quilt. Don't worry about having all of your fabric chosen at Month 1, we can work through building our color schemes and gather fabrics as we work! Please feel free to look through your booklets before class 1 and write down any ideas you have so we can hear your ideas! ☺
