### Class Description

**Make a “no sewn” block** using Freezer paper (stabilizer) with Muslin, Sharpie Pen, a light source (may be a window during the day or a light box), a coloring page and Crayola Crayons. Easy to do, all levels can color...tots to grandparents.

### Required Supplies

- Muslin 9” x 12” with freezer paper ironed to the back
  - The teacher will have this available for purchase in class - \$1 payable to Gail
- Crayola Crayons (brand name: Not sure how others will heat set)
- Sharpie **Pen** (black or color of your choice for tracing pattern)
- Coloring page (the theme is Christmas)
- Light source (we will have windows, but I will bring my homemade “light box”)
  
- A sewing machine is not needed for class, you may want to finish your block at home to make a quilt, wall-hanging or even a pillow

### Optional Supplies

- Come with a smile and have fun
- Stuff to finish your block later (thread, sashing strips, batting, binding and backing fabric)
- Imagination!

### Notes

This is a great class for adults and KIDS. Kids need an adult in class...no drop offs please. But, if an adult signs up the kid get ½ price...My 5 y/o great nephew made a block for baby brother’s new quilt and did an amazing job. For kid designs, keep it simple. The fewer lines to color in the better. It is okay to color outside the lines.
