

Crib Sheet Pattern

Supplies:

- 1 ¼ yard of flannel
- 2 1/3 yard elastic (I used ¼” braided elastic)

L x W x D = 38 ½” x 22” x 3 ½”

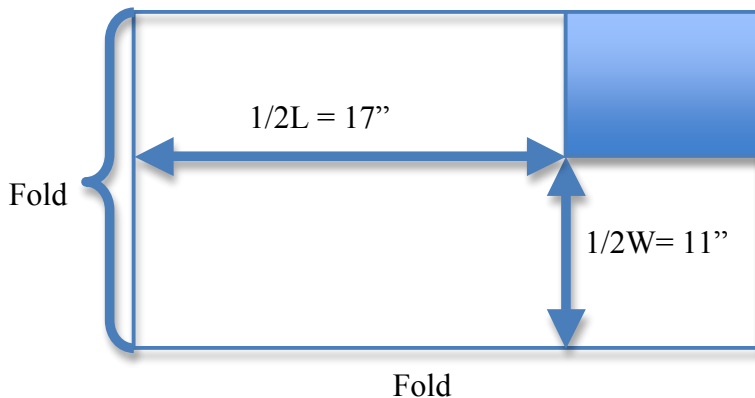
Extra Tuck = 2”

Starting Rectangle = 34” x 45 ½”

1/2L = 19 ¼”

1/2W = 11”

Once you have the starting rectangle cut, fold into quarters. You should have a fold on the left side and the bottom.



Measure ½ L and ½ W, then cut out the corner where those measurements meet.

Ie: for this sheet you will measure 17” (1/2L) and 11” (1/2 W). The darkened square is the extra you will need to cut out.

Sew up the corners to create the box shape of the sheet. This will be the depth, plus the extra you need for the casing. Fold the edge over ½” and press, fold over another ½” to create the casing. Edge stitch the casing, leaving a small opening to thread your elastic through. Once threaded, match the ends of the elastic and sew together; a small zig zag stitch works great. Once you’ve secured the ends of your elastic, stitch up your opening and you’re DONE!!
