Class Description

Want to create a more dramatic effect with your quilting? Looking for a way to draw more attention to certain parts of your quilt? You can create dimensional quilting by changing the way you approach things like stitch density and batting loft. This course will challenge you to think outside the box to really create a new dimension to your quilting. This class will be part drawing and part machine quilting – come with an open mind and ready for a challenge!

Required Supplies

- A sewing machine in good working order with the required presser feet, with ability to lower or cover the feed dogs.
 - Basic FMQ and Rulerwork supplies (FMQ foot and Ruler foot), along with your favorite straight edge ruler
 - Thread of your choice; you can choose to have matching thread to just see the quilting or a contrasting thread to add another element of dimension.
 - Basic sketching supplies – a notebook, pencil, pen or micron pen (small tip); whatever you like to draw with!
 - Batting Kit will be available for purchase from instructor (\$10) or you will need an 20” square of a base batting (such as quilters dream cotton – select) and dimension layer (such as quilters dream wool or dream puff). We will discuss batting options on the first night of class.
 - 18”-20” square of top fabric and 24” square of backing fabric – you can turn this into anything you want, but I envision a fun quilted pillow.
 - Marking pen – either the Wrights Water Soluble pen (blue) or the Dritz Fine Line pen (purple). We will discuss both in class.

- Note: If you are not able to bring your machine, you may rent a sewing machine from SLH. Please contact the shop at least 1 week in advance of class to ensure a machine is set up for you. ***Machine is not needed for the first class session – we will focus on drawing our design.**

Optional Supplies: An extended base will help you if you are using longer rulers, or just need a flatter base, there will be plenty of room so please feel free to bring one!
