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Class Description

Looking for a way to audition quilting designs before you start stitching? Are you unsure about where to start when deciding on quilting? Here is my secret: Draw it out!

In this class we will discuss how to approach a quilt when deciding what to actually quilt, how to navigate it through your quilt and what tools are out there to help you with this process! This technique can also help you discover what styles of quilting you like and gravitate toward!

Required Supplies

- Drawing Supplies - a notebook, pencil, pen or micron pen (small tip); whatever you like to draw with
- You may want a straight edge or compass and protractor depending on how creative you want to get with your drawing/quilting designs.
- Photos or copies of quilts you might want to “plan” quilting for.

Note: This is a drawing class, so no sewing machine is required.

Optional Supplies

- An iPad Pro with Pen (or other tablet with drawing capabilities) – we’ll discuss some nice drawing apps.
