



**Class Name: Felted Mittens – Community Service**

**Teacher Name: Debby Carter**

**Class Description:**

Come and learn how to make felted mittens. Make one pair from an old wool sweater and that pair will be donated to Covenant House. When you leave you will have a pattern and the know-how to make more mittens for yourself or friends!

**Two sewing sessions:**

10 am – 1 pm **OR** 2 pm – 5 pm

**Required Supplies:**

1. Sewing machine in working order
2. Fabric scissors, pins
3. Old felted wool sweater
4. Walking foot is very helpful
5. Neutral thread

**NOTES:** Bring a felted sweater (wash in hot water and dry on high – one time is usually enough). You might find a sweater or two at a good-used clothing store. Look for sweaters that have a minimum of 80% wool. You will also need a small piece of fleece (about 1/3 yard) to use for the lining. I will be bringing some sweaters and pieces of fleece to share as well.
