



Class Name: **Hoop Sister's 2018 Retreats 1st Quarter**

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Class Description

This is a 3 month class, where you will receive 3 project files each month. We will make 1, maybe 2 projects each month, depending on time. Each class is 6 hours long, enough time to finish 1 or more projects. We will use stabilizer and Hoop Sister's Battilizer™ (which is a combination of batting and stabilizer). You will learn to use the Trimmer by George II™. You will make a "Beans to Brew" wall hanging, coasters, cup cozies, make-up bag, eye glass and flat iron cases, a large travel bag, bag tag and travel slippers. This class is great for getting to know your embroidery machine.

Required Supplies

- Battilizer™, medium weight cutaway and tearaway stabilizers
- Trimmer by George II™
- 60 mm rotary cutter
- 12" and 22" nylon zippers
- Cotton fabrics (very fat quarter friendly)
- Polyester threads
- Water soluble thread
- Bobbin thread
- Embroidery scissors

[If applicable, include the following]

- An embroidery machine in good working order with the following presser feet:
 - #26 (Bernina) or embroidery foot
 - #1/#1D (Bernina) or straight stitch for sewing seams
 - Single hole stitch plate
 - Embroidery needles (80/12 or 90/14)
 - Various hoops (large oval [5" x 8"], mega, midi, maxi, maybe jumbo for larger projects)
- Note: If you are not able to bring your machine, you may rent an embroidery machine from SLH. Please contact the shop at least 1 week in advance of class to ensure a machine is set up for you
- Standard sewing supplies including: scissors, seam ripper, rotary cutter, ruler, mat, thread to match your project, bobbins and needle for your machine

Notes

Each month I will email the .pdf instruction files, so you can prepare for class ahead of time. I will let you know which projects we will be making and you can print them out and bring them to class. You will be able to gather fabric, threads and supplies before class and if you like, precut your fabric per instructions.
