Class Description:

This class will teach kids ages 8-14 how to thread and operate a sewing machine and provide a foundation in basic sewing skills as students make samples for their Seams and Samples Workbook. Once students have practiced all the techniques outlined in the Seams and Samples Workbook, we will stitch a series of fun and easy-to-complete projects: a drawstring bag, pin cushion, patchwork pillow, and hot chocolate cozy.

Notes:

- This class requires cumulative knowledge. If your kid's schedule does not accommodate attendance at all four sessions, please plan to take a future class. Make-up classes will not be given.
- This is a kids only class and as such parents are not allowed. We want kids to view the classroom as their sewing clubhouse. Since the store is not open for shopping during the class sessions, parents are encouraged to enjoy the class time without their kids. However, if you wish remain nearby, parents will need to wait in the parking lot.

Required Supplies:

The class fee includes:

- Use of a sewing machine
- Seams and Samples Workbook
- Fabric and supplies for practicing seams
- Fabric and supplies for completing the stitched projects
- Get started sewing kit

The materials will be given to students as needed so that nothing is lost between class sessions.

Kids should bring a snack to each session in case they get the munchies during all the learning fun.
