



Class Name: Make My First Quilt

Class Description:

In this class you will learn to choose fabrics, use a rotary cutter, sew a great $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and piece your first small quilt. We will complete the top with simple quilting and binding. This is a great technique class for anyone who wants to learn the skills necessary to make a quilt and gain the confidence to continue quilting!

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine in working order, power cord, foot pedal
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, a walking foot is highly recommended for the quilting
- Your **Sewing Machine Manual**
- Teach Me to Make my First Quilt, by Pat Sloan
- Two bobbins
- One spool of neutral colored thread
- Rotary cutter, 45 mm recommended
- Seam ripper
- Scissors for cutting threads
- Straight pins
- Crib size batting
- Fabric; approximately 2 yards for the quilt and 1 yard for backing

NOTES: We will talk about fabric selection and choose fabrics during the first class. You will be choosing a focal fabric, background fabric, 3 contrasting fat quarters, binding and backing fabrics. If you have fabrics already that you'd like to use, bring them along to the first class. During the class, you are welcome to use the cutting mats and rulers in the classroom, but you will eventually want to purchase your own as well.
