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### Class Description

We'll be making a simple top using a pattern from Love Notions. You will need to download the pattern from [lovenotions.com](http://lovenotions.com), print it out and tape the computer paper sheets together.

The Melody Dolman is a woven button-down dolman with shirt-tail hem. This dolman gives you a polished look without a lot of effort. If you're new to sewing button-down shirts, this is a great beginner pattern.

If you need a table space to tape your pattern together and trace your size, feel free to call and come in sometime **BEFORE** the class when Debby is working. That way we can check measurements to determine size.

### Required Supplies

- Melody Dolman pattern printed out from Love Notions
- Fabric as required from the pattern
- Five 1/2" buttons
- Shapeflex fusible interfacing
- Pattern ease to trace your size from the pattern
- Fabric for a wearable muslin if you want to make test shirt first
  
- A sewing machine in good working order with the following presser feet
- Thread
- Straight pins
  
- Note: If you are not able to bring your machine, you may rent a sewing machine from SLH. Please contact the shop at least 1 week in advance of class to ensure a machine is set up for you
  
- Standard sewing supplies including: scissors, seam ripper, rotary cutter, ruler, mat, thread to match your project, bobbins and needle for your machine
