Class Description

This is an easy multi pocket organizer that is great to fill with notions, bobbins, & sewing machine feet to take to classes, organize jewelry, makeup, the list goes on... It makes a fast, easy, and practical gift to give too!

Required Supplies

- What are the MUST HAVES?!
- 2 coordinating, NON directional fat quarters (one for back & one for the lining under the vinyl),
- 1/4 yard (straight) of coordinating fabric for binding, (or an additional fat quarter to contrast or can be the same fabric as back or lining).
- Clear vinyl by the yard or package. Piece must be able to be cut 12-1/2" x 19" for this project.
- 14" nylon zippers - project requires 3 for each organizer (Ideally, the same color so you don't need extra thread colors to match).
- Wonder tape is super important!
- Fusible fleece.
- Coordinating thread for both zipper tape & binding (don't forget extra bobbins).

- Sewing machine in good working order (remember to bring your foot pedal & power cord!)
- Rotary cutter/mat
- 6x24 inch ruler
- sharp scissors
- zipper foot
- Teflon foot (if you have one)
- Wonder clips (straight pins will not work for this project!)
- seam ripper
- Fabric marking pen or pencil
