Class Description

Are you new to paper piecing or just have that project that is stumping you? This a great class for you, sign up for one class or sign up for them all, we will be going over the basics of paper piecing as well as covering some tips and tricks. I'll help sort out more advanced patterns and can show you a great trick for measuring cut pieces so you don't have to rip out. I'll even show you an awesome way to rip(if you have to!)

Required Supplies

- Pattern of your choice- if you are a beginner Paper piecer, I suggest the "Alaska State" pattern by our own Abby Allan.
- Foundation paper – I suggest Carol Doaks Foundation paper
- Mini iron & mini pressing/cutting mat.
- Add a quarter ruler
- Seam Roller
- A piece of template plastic at least 2" x 10"

Other necessary class items:

- A sewing machine in good working order with either an open toe foot or general purpose foot
- Note: If you are not able to bring your machine, you may rent a sewing machine from SLH. Please contact the shop at least 1 week in advance of class to ensure a machine is set up for you!
- Standard sewing supplies including: rotary cutter, ruler, mat, thread to match your project, bobbins and NEW needles for your machine

Optional Supplies

- Other patterns I suggest: Trinket by Alison glass (beginner plus) , Orca at Sea by Northern threads (intermediate) Mini series by Guicy Guice,
