Class Description:

Join Enjoli to learn how to tackle quilting a Sampler Quilt. We will discuss a variety of different quilting designs. Each block will be quilted differently, while keeping a cohesive feel to the quilt. There will be both free-motion quilting and ruler work techniques in this class, therefore it is recommended that you be comfortable with both before signing up.

Required Supplies:

- Sampler Panel from Doodle Quilting Studio (included in your class fee, available for pick up prior to class.)
- 1 ¼ yard batting & backing to make a quilt sandwich. (at least 40" x 40")
- A working sewing machine with ability to lower or cover the feed dogs
- Thread for quilting – color of your choice – can be matching color if you'd like, but in interest of time we'll be sticking with one color over the whole thing!
- You will need both a FMQ foot and Ruler foot for your machine.

Optional Supplies:

- Any of your favorite quilting supplies (ie: quilting gloves, supreme slider)
- I highly recommend an extended table or tray for this class, as we will be using a variety of different size rulers, and manipulating a larger quilt sandwich.

***Notes:** Please have your Panel sandwiched and basted before you get to class. This will help us get the most out of our class time for quilting.
