### Class Description

So you know how to thread your serger and do a 4-thread overlock. What else can you do with your serger? Come and make a fun Ruffled Kitchen Towel! We'll learn and practice several serger stitches and put them together to make a towel that you could give as a gift.

You must be confident threading your serger, changing needles and adjusting tensions.

### Required Supplies

- Working serger
  - Double eyed needle
  - Tweezers
  - Needle screw driver
  - Fray check
  - Three 2 1/2" strips
  - Thread to coordinate with your strips - 3 spools or cones
  - One package single fold bias tape to coordinate with strips
  - Some extra fabric scraps to practice stitches
  - Thread scissors
