Class Description:

We will be working on Serpentine! The FIRST time EVER this quilt has been taught by TULA!! . Foundation Paper Piecing is a technique used to stabilize fabrics. It is the method of machine sewing fabrics to paper (or muslin or other stabilizers) to create intricate shapes or details in quilt blocks and perfect points!

This is a machine sewing class.

Supplies:

- ***Foundation Paper- Carol Doaks Foundation paper!**
(please have your foundations copied prior to class!)
- ***Mini cutting/pressing mat, or wool pressing mat- having your own next to you will expedite your sewing time!**
- * **Mighty Steam Iron- again having this next to you will be helpful!**
- * **Rotary cutter for cutting and trimming**
- * **Add-A-Quarter Ruler**
- * **Template plastic/card stock for folding**
- * **If you don't have a mini iron you can also use a seam roller :) (We like Violet Craft seam rollers)**

Limited number of Fabric kits will be available using Tula Pink Pinkerville fabrics. We will also have additional fabric kits using Alison Glass fabrics

Please call the shop to reserve your fabric kit!

You will need your sewing machine and basic sewing supplies as well.

- * **Additionally we are going to try to squeeze in a pre cutting session for those enrolled in this class, that way you are all ready to start sewing when you come!**
