**Class Description:**

**Required Supplies:**

- Alaskan Parka Pattern by Lois # 109 in the size you need
- Cotton fabric: 2-3 yards, depending on the size
- 6-8" zipper, depending on the size
- Trim: 2,5 - 4 yards depending on the size
- Matching thread
- Scissors
- A working sewing machine

**Optional Supplies:**

- Anything extra that might help them complete the project, but is not critical
