



**Class Name:** Simple Top w/Handkerchief Hem

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### **Class Description:**

This top is not as intimidating as you may think & will be a great addition to your wardrobe! We will be using Rayon Batiks that are not only beautiful, but have a flattering flowy drape. I'll bring samples and we'll also discuss lots of different ways to customize this super easy, cute, & comfy top.

Note: Machine washing *and* machine drying your fabric prior to class is required homework.

### **Required Supplies:**

- 2 ½ yards of **non-directional** Rayon Batik fabric.  
*(FABRIC NOTE: If you choose to purchase your Rayon at JoAnn's, you'll need to get 2 ¾ yards to allow for unpredictable shrinkage – to ensure proper fit, the fabric **MUST be pre-washed, dried, & pressed prior to coming to class!**)*
- Coordinating thread
- 2 ½ yards of Pattern Ease or another pattern tracing medium to trace my pattern
- Sharp sewing machine needle

### **You'll also need to bring the following basic sewing notions to complete this top:**

Sewing machine in good working order (remember to bring your foot pedal & power cord!)	
large, sharp scissors	seam ripper
straight pins	tape measure
Pen or pencil	zig zag foot

I know our lives get busy, but **I cannot stress enough**, the importance of pre-shrinking your fabric! It would be awful if your top didn't fit you after washing it the first time :o(

**(I've known Rayon to shrink anywhere from 3 to 6 inches!)**

***And... Please press your fabric (w/steam)***
