2018 Sisterhood Retreat Part 1, includes 3 themes with 9 Quilt-In-The-Hoop projects - 3 projects each month. We will make at least one project in class, maybe two each month.

Part 1 includes features the following themes:

Back to School – September

Baby – October

Sewing - December

Get to know your embroidery machine along with your Hoop Sisters Quilt-In-The-Hoop certified teacher. These projects are very useful and would make great gifts too.

Required Supplies:

- Light weight tear-away stabilizer
- Sticky stabilizer (sewing theme)
- Batillizer
- USB stick (at least 1GB but no larger than 2GB)
- Hoop Sister's Trimmer © by George II
- 60mm Rotary Cutter
- Variety of fabrics: some fat quarter friendly; solids and prints, a few batiks
- ½" Grommets (Back to School; Sewing theme)
- Embroidery thread (match/contrast fabrics)
- Bobbin thread
- Water soluble thread
- HoopShape or Flex Foam (for some of the projects)
- Embroidery scissors for close embroidery trimming in the hoop
- A working embroidery machine/or a request to borrow one from the shop.
- Hoops, Large Oval, Midi, Maxi (Bernina) to largest (Jumbo for Bernina: Beans to Brew quilt)

Optional Supplies:

- Wool batting (not all the projects)
- ¾" bias tape maker (for making sashing)
