



**Class Name: Snow Skirt – Make it in a Weekend**

**Class Description:**

Now you can make your very own Snow Skirt. Choose from the variety of pattern styles and colors of rip stop and trims to make this warm winter garment uniquely your own! Once you learn to make one for yourself, you can make others for family and friends. They will be asking!!

**Required Supplies:**

- Working Sewing machine, foot pedal, power cord, regular foot, zipper foot, machine needles
- Fabric scissors, straight pins
- Snow Skirt pattern (each student must purchase their own pattern)  
Choose Snow Skirt, It's a Wrap, SnoMotion or girls' pattern
- 1-yard pattern ease to trace your size & pencil to trace
- Parka lining and rip stop fabrics as required by pattern
- 26" or 28" two-way zipper – for Snow Skirt
- 14" separating zipper – for SnoMotion or It's A Wrap
- 9" or longer coil zipper for pocket
- Wonder tape (can be shared with another student)
- One package double fold bias tape or 1 – 1 ½ yards ½" twill tape
- Thread to match your rip stop fabric
- One small shank button

**Optional Supplies:**

- Walking foot is not necessary but very helpful
- Trim for skirt – can be purchased later – 2 - 3 yards
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**NOTES:** Please be sure to have **ALL** of your supplies purchased and ready before the class begins. If you would like help in choosing materials, just ask to find out when I will be working at Seam Like Home. I will be happy to assist you.

**Class Schedule:** On Friday evening, we will trace your size from pattern, cut the materials and create the zippered pocket. We will continue constructing the skirt on Saturday. Feel free to bring a lunch or snacks for Saturday.
