Class Description:

Make a colorful abstract quilted wall hanging from a single star block or combine a few blocks into a bed quilt of any size. This is a perfect pattern to use all of the scraps and fabrics left over from your previous projects or to showcase the beautiful Hoffman Watercolor fabrics available at SLH. Depending on your fabric selection, this quilt can decorate any room, from nursery to office, and match any decor, from country to urban.

Required Supplies:

- A working sewing machine
- Matching or neutral thread
- Rotary cutter and mat
- 1 yard background fabric
- 16 fabric scraps in a variety of colors for the star body and points
- Border, backing, and binding fabrics
- Batting

Optional Supplies:

As a suggestion, and for students' information, the following Hoffman Watercolor same texture fabrics in various colors were used in the sample:

- background and backing: #413 Watercress
- star body: #366 Vienna, #178 Leaf, #58 Earth, #411 scones, #434 Radish, #354 Kelly, #67 Flame, #46 Plum
- star points: #410 Earl Grey, #468 Petunia, #310 Fire, #23 Agate, #189 Christmas Green, #192 Pumpkin, #342 Woody, #595 October
- inner border: #58 Earth
- outer border: #67 Flame
- binding: strips of star body fabrics
