Modern Placemat

Supplies:

- Your serger in good working order, including instruction manual and accessories ✓
- Thread
 - 3 cones Maxi Lock Serger thread (to coordinate with or contrast fabric) ✓
- 2 yards Heat N Bond Ultrahold ✓
- Tapestry Needle
- Fray Check or Fray Block ✓
- Fabric (4 placemats 15"x15")
 - 2 yards wool or premium felt (lightweight craft felt will not work well here)
 - Cotton fabrics to mix and match: 4 or 5 fabrics make a good mix. These fabrics will be the strips on the front of the placemat. Use scraps, or fat quarters will work well.
 - Optional napkins: 1 yard cotton fabric (4 18"x18" napkins)



Pre-club prep:

- Cut from felt:
 - 4 -16"x16" squares for the backing
 - Approximately 20 strips of varying widths from 2" to 4" x 16". These strips will be on the front of the placemat.
- Cut from the cotton fabrics:
 - Approximately 20 strips of varying widths from 2" to 4" x 16"
