You will gather your fabrics and threads for your project and bring them, along with your machine and additional feet you may have to each class...no looking for a supply list for each class. Yeah!



Project ideas:

- Jacket
- Table Runner
- Wall Hanging
- Shawl
- Reference Binder or Inspiration Guide

First Class:

- Gather fabrics and threads; bring them along with your machine and accessories. We will discuss and plan our projects! Then we will talk **pintucks**.
- If you are unsure where to begin, bring your machine and some fabric to do samples, as well as two Maxi Lock and one decorative thread for the first day – I will walk you through what to do next!

Basic Supplies:

- Your serger in good working order, including instruction manual and accessories ✓
- Any feet for your serger that you may have ✓
- Your fabrics
- Your threads ✓
- Basic sewing supplies: scissors, marking tools, clips ✓

Jacket Supplies:

- Grainline Studios Tamarack Jacket Pattern (I will take orders on the first day) or any simple Jacket pattern of your choice.
- Main Fabric: 45" – 3 yds/ 60" – 2 yds or per your pattern
- 6 fat quarters
- Thread (I used Woolly Nylon, Sulky Blendables, Pearl Crown Rayon, Maxi Lock) to contrast and coordinate with your fabrics

Table Runner, Shawl, or Wall Hanging:

- 2 yards Main Fabric
- 6 fat quarters
- Assorted decorative threads as above to coordinate and contrast with your fabrics
