

# Zippered Cosmetic Bag

In this class you will learn to insert a zipper with your serger and make a bag with boxed corners.

## *Supplies Needed:*

- One 12-1/2" x 15" rectangle of quilter's cotton for the main fabric
- One 12-1/2" x 15" rectangle of quilter's cotton for the lining fabric
- One 2-1/2" x 5" rectangle of quilter's cotton fabric -or- 5" of 1" wide ribbon for the tabs
- One 12-1/2" x 15" rectangle of fusible interfacing (optional, provides body to the main fabric – recommend Shape-Flex) ✓
- One 18" or longer all-purpose zipper with plastic coils (No metal coils, no separating zippers)
- 4 spools Maxi-Lock thread to blend with fabrics ✓
- Serger in good working order with manual and all accessories needed to do a 4-thread overlock stitch ✓
- General sewing and serging supplies (pins, scissors, tweezers, seam gauge, Wonder Tape, etc.) ✓
- Piping or Cording Foot for your serger (**required** for zipper insertion) ✓
- "Junk" scissors (will be used to cut off the zipper ends) ✓

## *Supply Notes:*

- If you change the dimensions of the bag, the zipper needs to be at least 4 to 6" longer than the fabric it will be applied to. In the sample bag, the zipper is applied to the 12-1/2" side.

## *Pre-Class Preparation:*

1. Fuse the fusible interfacing to the wrong side of the rectangle of main fabric.
2. Set up the serger for a 4-thread overlock with serger thread in both needles and the loopers.
