## Double Flying Geese Star <br> Class \#7

Thursday, November 2, 2023 with Helen Coleman

We will make a square within a square of flying geese this month. The finished square will be a $12 \times 12$ only. Cut everything you need for the $6 \times 6$ square and also for the $12 \times 12$ square, substituting the 6 -inch finished square for the center of the 12 -inch square.

Supply List: ( $\checkmark$ indicates you can buy this at Dublin Sewing Center)

- Sewing machine in good working order $\checkmark$
- Threads to blend with your fabric $\checkmark$
- Bobbins, prewound with thread to coordinate with your fabric $\checkmark$

- Travel size cutting board (Optional but useful) $\checkmark$
- Quilters' squares in various sizes $\checkmark$
- Half square triangle $\checkmark$
- Quarter square triangle $\checkmark$
- Rotary cutter $\checkmark$
- Seam ripper $\checkmark$
- Small scissors or snips for cutting thread $\checkmark$
- Travel iron and pressing board (optional, but handy as we will be doing lots of pressing)
- Needles $\checkmark$
- Clips and/or pins $\checkmark$
- $1 / 4$ inch presser foot $\checkmark$

And remember to bring all your scraps to class!
For this month, use the same color fabric for your small center square and your star points.

| Piece | \# needed | Center Square <br> $(6 \times 6$ finished) | Sorry! No $9 \times 9$ <br> this month! | Large (Size $12 \times 12$ ) |

| Center square <br> (Same as star points for <br> inner star) | 1 square | $311 / 2 \times 31 / 2$ |  | Cut and make the $6 \times 6$ <br> finished square for the <br> center of the large <br> square |
| Star fabric | 4 squares | $23 / 8 \times 23 / 8$ |  | $37 / 8 \times 37 / 8$ |
| Corners (background <br> fabric) | 4 squares | $2 \times 2$ | $31 / 2 \times 31 / 2$ |  |
| Large square background <br> fabric as base for flying <br> geese | 1 square <br> (Makes 4) | $41 / 4 \times 41 / 4$ |  | $71 / 4 \times 71 / 4$ |
