Double Flying Geese Star

We will make a square within a square of flying geese this month. The finished square will be a 12x12 only. Cut everything you need for the 6x6 square and also for the 12 x 12 square, substituting the 6-inch finished square for the center of the 12-inch square.



Supply List: (✓ indicates you can buy this at Dublin Sewing Center)

- Sewing machine in good working order ✓
- Threads to blend with your fabric ✓
- Bobbins, prewound with thread to coordinate with your fabric ✓
- Travel size cutting board (Optional but useful) ✓
- Quilters' squares in various sizes ✓
- Half square triangle ✓
- Quarter square triangle ✓
- Rotary cutter ✓
- Seam ripper ✓
- Small scissors or snips for cutting thread ✓
- Travel iron and pressing board (optional, but handy as we will be doing lots of pressing) ✓
- Needles ✓
- Clips and/or pins ✓
- ¼ inch presser foot ✓

And remember to bring all your scraps to class!

For this month, use the same color fabric for your small center square and your star points.

| Piece | # needed | Center Square (6x6 finished) | Sorry! No 9 x 9 this month! | Large (Size 12 x 12) |
|---|-----------------------|---------------------------------|--------------------------------|--|
| Center square (Same as star points for inner star) | 1 square | 3 ½ x 3 ½ | | Cut and make the 6 x 6 finished square for the center of the large square |
| Star fabric | 4 squares | 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 | | 3 7/8 x 3 7/8 |
| Corners (background fabric) | 4 squares | 2 x 2 | | 3 ½ x 3 ½ |
| Large square background fabric as base for flying geese | 1 square (Makes 4) | 4 ¼ x 4 ¼ | | 7 ¼ x 7 ¼ |
