Once you've inserted your dark line, this star is really easy!!


Supply List:

- Sewing machine in good working order $\checkmark$
- Threads to blend with your fabric $\checkmark$
- Bobbins, prewound $\checkmark$
- Travel size cutting board (Optional but useful) $\checkmark$
- Quilters' squares in various sizes $\checkmark$
- Half square triangle $\checkmark$
- Quarter square triangle
- Tri Tool and Recs Tool by Darlene Zimmerman and Joy Hoffman $\checkmark$
- Rotary cutter $\checkmark$
- Seam ripper $\checkmark$
- Small scissors or snips for cutting thread $\checkmark$
- Travel iron and pressing board (optional, but handy as we will be doing lots of pressing)
- Needles $\checkmark$
- Clips and/or pins $\checkmark$
- $1 / 4$ inch presser foot $\checkmark$

In addition to all your sewing supplies, bring all your leftover fabric in case you need to make corrections in class.

## Bold = $\mathbf{1 2}$ inch finished square (top)

Green = 9 inch finished square (middle)
Red $=6$ inch finished square (bottom)

| Fabric | Number | Size |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Points (my red) | 4 regular Rec Triangles 4 reversed Rec Triangles | $\begin{aligned} & 41 / 2 \text { strip } \\ & 31 / 2 \text { strip } \\ & 21 / 2 \text { strip } \end{aligned}$ |
| Center (my red) | 1 square | $41 / 2$ square <br> $31 / 2$ square <br> $21 / 2$ square |
| Background (my white) <br> (it's ok to use 4 shorter strips as long as they total more than the given length | 2 strips | $21 / 4$ inch strips 28 inches each <br> $13 / 8$ strips 16 inches each |
| Narrow stripe in border (my dark) <br> (again, 2 short strips ok) | 1 strip | 1 inch strip 28 inches long 1 inch strip 22 inches long $3 / 4$ inch strip 16 inches long |
