Another star variation!! You can make the outer layer of black a different fabric for a double square look. And the center can be totally different if desired. This is your time to experiment with fabrics!


Supply List: ( $\checkmark$ indicates you can buy this at Dublin Sewing Center)

- Sewing machine in good working order $\checkmark$
- Threads to blend with your fabric $\checkmark$
- Bobbins, prewound with thread to coordinate with your fabric
- Travel size cutting board (Optional but useful) $\checkmark$
- Quilters' squares in various sizes $\checkmark$
- Rotary cutter $\checkmark$
- Seam ripper $\checkmark$
- Small scissors or snips for cutting thread $\checkmark$
- Travel iron and pressing board (optional, but handy as we will be doing lots of pressing)
- Needles
- Clips and/or pins
- $1 / 4$ inch presser foot $\checkmark$

And remember to bring all your scraps to class!!

| Fabric | Number | Small (6x6) | Medium (9x9) | Large (12x12) |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Background (my white) | 4 squares | $2^{1 / 2} \times 21 / 2$ | $3112 \times 31 / 2$ | $4112 \times 41 / 2$ |
| Background | 1 square cut twice diagonally to make 4 quarter square triangles | $31 / 4 \times 31 / 4$ | $4^{11 / 4 \times 41 / 4}$ | $51 / 4 \times 51 / 4$ |
| Outer box (my smaller black triangles) | 4 squares -draw diagonal line on each-DON'T cut!!! | $11 / 2 \times 11 / 2$ | $2 \times 2$ | $21 / 2 \times 21 / 2$ |
| Stars | 2 squares, each cut twice on diagonal to make 8 quarter square triangles | $31 / 4 \times 31 / 4$ | $4^{11 / 4 \times 41 / 4}$ | $5^{11 / 4 \times 51 / 4}$ |
| Inner box (my black larger triangles) | 1 square, cut twice on diagonal to make 4 quarter square triangles | $3114 \times 31 / 4$ | $4114 \times 41 / 4$ | $5114 \times 51 / 4$ |
| Center square | 1 square | $2^{1 / 2} \times 21 / 2$ | $3112 \times 31 / 2$ | $4^{1 / 2} \times 41 / 2$ |
