Let's make a knit tee shirt using our sergers! This can also be made with a sewing machine. Pamela's Pattern has become one of my favorite go to's for a quick and easy wardrobe staple. The pattern is quite easy to adjust to your particular body size. The pattern details include "an essence of waist" with a flattering shirt hemline, three necklines, and multiple sleeve lengths. We will work on creating a perfect fit and leave with a pattern you can use again and again. We'll address common questions regarding sewing with knits.



Supply list:

Pattern

 Pamela's Perfect T-Shirt pattern. This will need to be purchased before class so you can cut your fabric before class. ✓

Fabric

 Good quality knit fabric in yardage as indicated on the pattern for your size. Please follow the sizing chart to determine if you will need darts.

Thread

3-4 spools of Maxi Lock serger thread to match fabrics ✓

Other Items

- Baby Lock Serger in good working order with all manuals and accessories that came with the machine. You should know how to thread your serger and the basic operation of the machine. Instructions on how to use your serger will not be provided in class. ✓
- Alternately, you can make this shirt using a regular sewing machine in good working order.
 As with the serger, please bring all manuals and accessories that came with the machine.
 You should have a basic working knowledge of your machine. ✓
- Fusible Woven Stay Tape ✓
- Knit Stay Tape ✓
- Portable iron and ironing board/pad (optional but helpful) ✓
- Personal desktop light (optional but helpful) ✓
- General Sewing Supplies
