

# Basel Raglan Knit Top by Styla Patterns

If you want to learn how to sew a shirt using knit fabric on your sewing machine, then this is the class for you! In this class you will learn how to determine your size and trace your pattern on to tracing paper.

The Styla Basel Raglan is a semi-fitted raglan knit top with a unique pintuck front that can be made with a variety of sleeves.

Note: While this shirt can be sewn on either a serger or a sewing machine, we will be using a sewing machine for this class.



## ***Supplies Needed***

- Basel raglan top pattern (purchased via the Styla Patterns website <https://littlelizardking.com/products/styla-basel>) Please print pages 1-7 of the document named Styla\_Basel\_Tutorial and bring to class.
- Suggested Fabric (pre-washed):
  - Good quality medium weight knit fabric with good stretch and recovery including but not limited to:
    - French Terry
    - Jersey
    - Interlock
    - Cotton Lycra
    - Double Brushed Poly
  - 1-1/2 yds – 2-1/2 yds. 54" - 60" wide fabric, depending on your size and preferred sleeve length. We will be making the simple neck band, not the turtleneck.
- Notions and other supplies
  - Sewing machine that has zig-zag and/or stretch stitch options in good working order, with accessories and manual. You must have a good working knowledge of you machine. We will not be teaching you how to use your machine in class. ✓
  - Fabric scissors ✓
  - Pins ✓
  - Wonder Clips ✓
  - Ball Point Needle ✓
  - Swedish tracing paper ✓
  - Good quality polyester thread to match your fabric ✓
  - Knit Stay Tape ✓
  - Fabric guide (optional) ✓

- Curved Ruler (used for alterations) (optional) ✓ (this will have to be a special order)
- Pencil and eraser
- Scotch tape
- Ruler

### ***Pre-class preparation***

1. Pre-wash and dry your fabric in a method that you will be using to wash your finished garment. If your fabric is wrinkled after washing/drying, iron the entire piece.
2. I will be printing the pattern pieces out in all sizes to use for tracing your own pattern, but if you would like to print your own pattern pieces out yourself, you are welcome to do so. If so, please follow the instructions on page 17 of the document named *Styla\_Basel\_Tutorial* and bring to class.
