

ByAnnie Bag-Travel Essentials 2.0

In this 2-day class we will make an organizer bag for travel. Carry your essentials in style with this handy set. The organizer has mesh and vinyl pockets for visible storage and a deep zippered pocket on the bottom for larger items. The coordinating Hot Tool Sleeve has 2 compartments, including an outer pocket for cords. The bag requires 1 yard of fabric, and the coordinating sleeve requires 1/2 yard of fabric. This bag organizes and stores a lot of toiletry items!! The bag folds compactly or opens flat for easy access. You can carry this bag with a quick grab handle or an adjustable, detachable strap.



Supplies Needed

- The ByAnnie pattern “Travel Essentials 2.0”. Purchase this pattern from the ByAnnie website [HERE](#)
- A main and a lining and fabric – 1 yard each for the Organizer and ½ yard each for the Sleeve
- A coordinating fabric – ¾ yard for the Organizer and ½ yard for the Sleeve
- ByAnnie’s soft and stable – 18” x 58” for
- Fusible interfacing (SF101) 1/3 yard for the Organizer ✓
- Mesh fabric for the inner pockets – 5” x 13” piece
- Vinyl for inner pockets – 8” x 12” piece
- ByAnnie’s handbag zippers – a minimum of 80” of zipper tape and 5 zipper pulls
- 1” Polypro strapping – 3 yards
- 1 inch hardware”
 - For bag closure – 1 D-ring, e swivel hook
 - For hanging strap – 1 D-ring
 - For carrying strap – 1 D-ring or triangle ring, 1 swivel hook, 1 wide-mouth slider
- Thread to compliment fabrics ✓

Notions and other supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order with zipper foot and ¼” foot, with accessories that came with the machine ✓
- Rotary cutter ✓
- Fabric scissors ✓
- Pins ✓
- Wonder clips ✓
- 90/14 machine needle ✓
- Clover chalk pen ✓
- Quilters rulers ✓

- ByAnnie's stiletto tool ✓
- Quick turn fabric tube turning tool ✓
- Bodkin for pulling strapping through the tube ✓
- A portable light will help but not mandatory

Pre-Class preparation

Purchase the pattern on the ByAnnie website. Don't prewash your fabric but put the 3 layers together; main, soft and stable and lining fabric and quilt the three pieces together. Cut out all the quilted fabric pieces and seal the edges. Cut out the remaining pieces required for the project and attach the included labels to keep track of all the various components. I will bring my Creative Grids Circle Rulers for your use in class. This bag is a big project and WILL require you to do homework. Call me or text me if you have any questions.
