Cutwork Lingerie Bag.

Creating a hemstitched pillowcase and encasing with French seams.

Supplies Needed

Fabric & Such

- 1 yard of preshrunk batiste fabric. This will make two pillowcases.
- Cut 2 pieces of Floriani Wet and Gone large enough to hoop 5 X 7. ✓
- Floriani Stitch N Wash Water Soluble Tear Away stabilizer. ✓

Thread

- Embroidery thread, your choice of brand and color ✓

Needles, Notions & Stabilizer

- 80 or 90 Microtex or Embroidery Needles ✓
- 130/705-H wing needle 120 OR Twin Wing 130/705 H-ZWIHO 100 Double Hemstitch needle, depending on the look you want. ✓
- 1pre wound bobbin of embroidery thread ✓
- Thread snips or scissors ✓
- In the Hoop Applique Scissors ✓

Machine & Accessories

- Embroidery machine in good working order with manual, 5 X 7" hoop ✓

Pre-Class Preparation:

Cutting:

Cut your fabric 26" by the WOF. Press a 1" seam across the 26" side. Fold that down another 1" and press. Bring the folded 1" piece down 3" and press again. This will be the top of the pillowcase. Bring your remainder fabric to audition the hemstitch you choose to use.
