Supplies Needed

- Applique Designs - purchased from Embroidery Library and Loaded on to your embroidery machine.

- Floriani No-Show Nylon Mesh Fusible stabilizer ✓
- Fabric:
 - Placemat top: 21" x 17 1/2" of bottom-weight cotton or cotton/poly blend solid-color fabric (Once the applique is finished, this top piece will be cut down to 17" x 12")
 - Placemat bottom and border: 21" x 16" rectangle print quilting cotton fabric
 - Teapot and Tea Cup body: Two 6" x 8" rectangle print quilting cotton fabric
 - Spout, lid, and saucer: One 6" x 8" rectangle print quilting cotton fabric
- Thread
 - 3 different colors of 40 wt Floriani or Isacord polyester machine embroidery thread:
 - Color 1 for tea spout, teapot handle, and saucer ✓
 - Color 2 for tea cup and teapot body ✓
 - Color 3 for tea in cup and spout top. ✓(refer to the color change charts that come with the designs)
 - 1 bobbin with 60 wt machine embroidery bobbin thread ✓
- Size 90 embroidery needle (Chrome-type preferred, since appliqué can be bulky) ✓
- Good quality scissors with sharp tips (for cutting out the appliqué designs in class) ✓
- Temporary spray adhesive ✓
- Water-soluble marking pen ✓
- Straight pins, to help with placemat assembly ✓
- Embroidery-capable machine with a 5" x 7" hoop, embroidery unit, power cord, manuals, etc. (If students bring an embroidery-only machine they will not be able to complete the placemat in class.) ✓



Students will need to do some pre-class preparation; instructions will be sent prior to class.
