



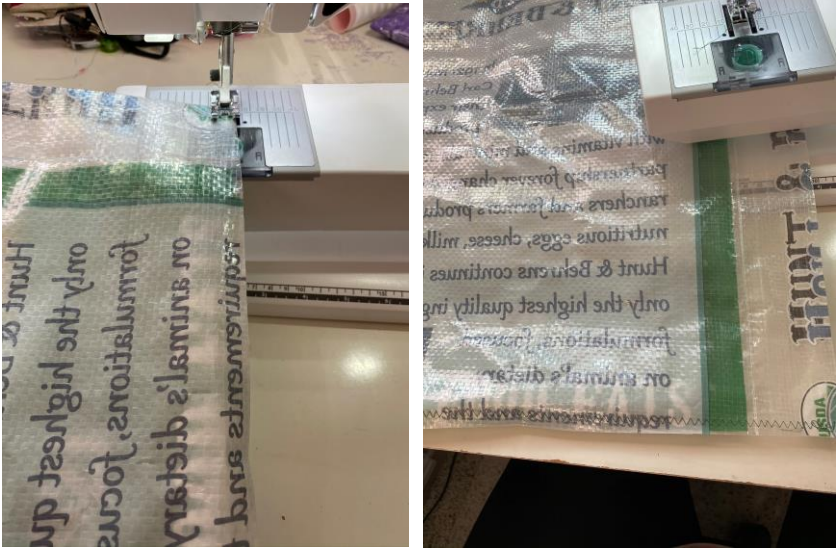
Big Bay Ray Shopping Bags – Pattern for a shopping bag made from a feeding bag

One small bag, 16inch to 18inch, for a big bag you need 20inch to 22inch

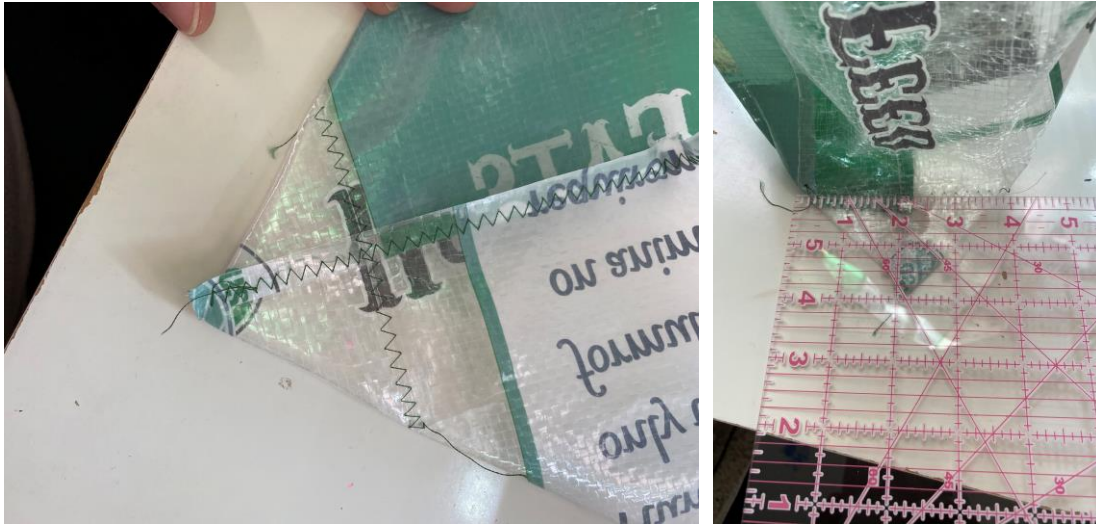
Cut the feeding bag on the top and measure out the size of the bag you want to sew. Please leave enough space around the horse picture on the bag.



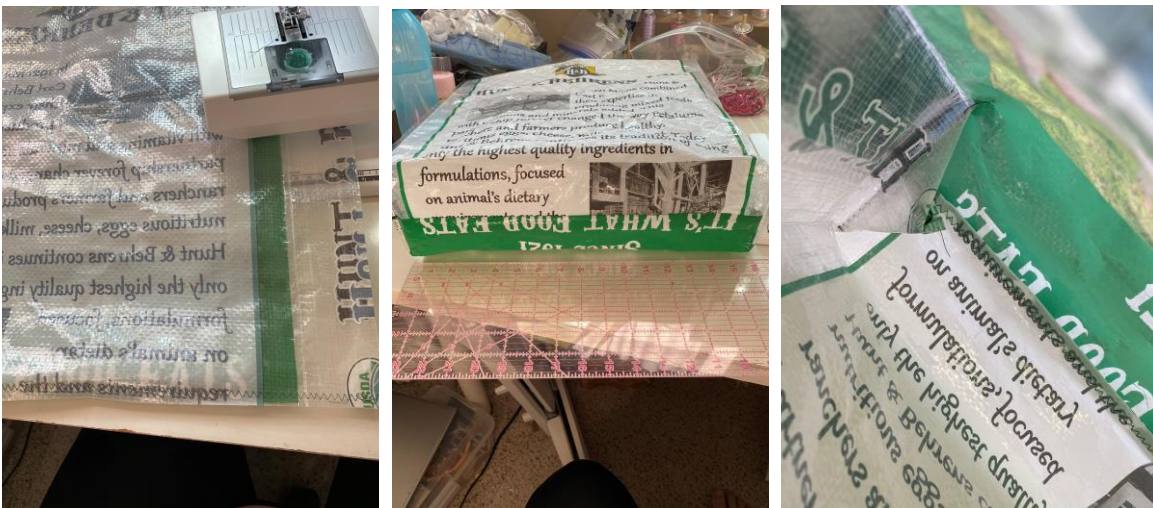
Turn around the bag from outside to inside. Sew the bottom first.



Use the zigzag stitch to close the bottom of the bag. After sewing the bottom grab the edges and fold them up into a triangle. The line you must sew on the triangle edges should have the same length as the width of the side of the bag.



After sewing both edges on the bottom, turn bag back around from inside to outside.

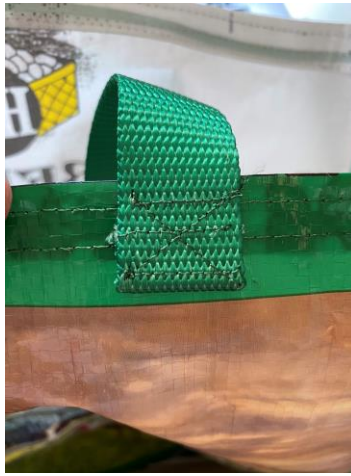
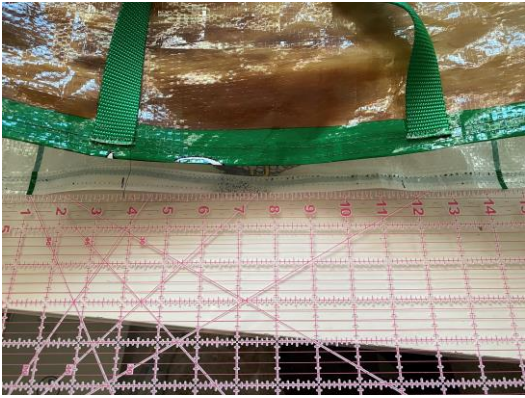


Now sew in the top of the bag. First fold it in around a half inch, sew around. Then fold it in a second time between half inch to an inch. Sew around either in a zigzag stitch or use two straight lines.



Now sew the handles on. I like to measure from outside around 4 to 5 inches in to place the handles.





And finally!! Done!
