## Class Supply List

If you took Wanda's successful Battenburg Lace class, you know she is an excellent teacher! She is ready to teach many embroidery techniques with her next project called I Love Flowers Quilt for 2020. Two methods of machine applique will be covered in this class. You will also learn multi-hooping, precise positioning of designs, use of templates, and using your Mega Hoop.

This is a great class to learn all the exciting features of your embroidery machine!

**Prior to the first class, Wanda will email you the first design and layout instructions.**



- “I Love Flowers” Designs – Purchase from Wanda for \$10.00. You will do this during the first class.
- Print PDF File that is in your email. Insert printed files into plastic sheet protectors and put in binder. Make sure you bring this binder to class each month, as we will be adding new files to it. Before each class, Wanda will email the design files and accompanying PDF files to insert into your binder.
- 2 Yards background fabric, to be appliqued on. **Please wash, dry, starch, and iron before first class.**
- Lots of Fabric scraps in assorted colors for Applique and Block Borders.
- 2 Yards Lightweight Fusible Fleece, Pellon 987F or Floriani Heat N Sta Light Fusible Fleece (59” X 1 yard)
- 1-yard Steam A Seam 2 Lite ✓
- Medium Weight Tear Away Stabilizer ✓
- Sulky 2000 Temporary Spray ✓
- Air and Heat Erasable Marking Pens ✓
- Pencil for tracing designs on Steam A Seam
- 6” x 24” Quilting Ruler ✓
- Rotary Cutter ✓
- Scissors ✓
- Sharp Tweezers ✓
- Applique Scissors, or curved tip scissors ✓
- Embroidery Thread to co-ordinate with fabric scraps for applique. ✓
- Basic Sewing Supplies ✓
- Embroidery Machine in good working condition with at least a 5” x 7” embroidery field. ✓
- Mega Hoop (if your machine has one), Large Hoop, and 5x7 Hoop (if you have one). Also, please bring you sewing machine manual. ✓

Please put your name on all hoops and sewing supplies.
