The Jelly Roll Basket base is made from the Jelly-Roll Rug Pattern, then you will manipulate and shape the fabric strips into an oval bowl. You will also learn how to make a fabric flower and attach with a button to your bowl.

Supplies Needed

- Jelly-Roll Rug Pattern ✓
- One roll Bosal Katahdin Organic Cotton 2.5" x 25 yds ✓
- Ten 2.5" x 42" strips cotton or batik fabric
- Size 16 Jeans sewing machine needles ✓
- One large spool (Aurifil spool 50wt or 40wt works well) of plain or variegated thread that will blend or contrast with your fabrics ✓
- 2 - 3 bobbins pre-wound before class with your large spool above
- Mary Ellen's Best Press ✓
- Clover Wonder Clips (medium size) 20 or more is recommended ✓
- Roxanne Glue-Baste-It ✓
- 1 hand sewing needle ✓
- 1 large button to compliment bowl colors
- Walking foot (optional) ✓
- Sewing machine in good working order. Your machine must be able to sew a 5.0 mm or 5.5 mm zig zag stitch. Check your owner's manual to be sure your machine can sew this wide stitch. For best results, your machine must also be strong enough to sew through multiple layers. You must know how to thread your machine, wind bobbins and sew a zig zag stitch.
