

# Jelly Roll Placemat

The Jelly Roll Placemat is a smaller, quicker version of the Jelly-Roll Rug 2 pattern. After making your placemat, you will be able to make the large Jelly-Roll Rug on your own.

### Supplies Needed

- Jelly-Roll Rug 2 Pattern ✓
- One roll Bosal Katahdin Organic Cotton 2.5" x 25 yds ✓
- Jelly Roll/Fabric
  - One good quality cotton or batik Jelly Roll (consists of 40-42 precut fabric strips 2.5" x 42"). This will make four placemats. Or
  - 20 precut fabric strips 2.5" x 42" cotton or batik fabric strips of your choice. This will make two placemats.
- Size 16 Jeans sewing machine needles ✓
- One large spool (Aurifil spool 50wt or 40wt works well) of plain or variegated thread that will blend or contrast with your fabrics ✓
- 2-3 bobbins pre-wound before class with your large spool above
- Mary Ellen's Best Press ✓
- Clover Wonder Clips (medium size) ✓
- Roxanne Glue-Baste-It ✓
- 1 hand sewing needle ✓
- Walking foot (optional) ✓
- Sewing machine in good working order. Your machine must be able to sew a 5.0 mm or 5.5 mm zig zag stitch. Check your owner's manual to be sure your machine can sew this wide stitch. For best results, your machine must also be strong enough to sew through multiple layers. You must know how to thread your machine, wind bobbins and sew a zig zag stitch.
