Supplies:

- Your sewing machine with instructional manual and accessories **✓
- Pattern - Pamela's Magic Pencil Skirt ✓
- Fabric and notions per your pattern envelope
- 1" Sew on Elastic (not non roll elastic). Your wais measurement plus 2"
- Fabric: Heavy Weight Knit such as Ponte
- Swedish Tracing Paper ✓
- Basic sewing supplies ✓
- Scissors ✓
- Marking pen or chalk ✓
- Pins or clips ✓
- Thread ✓
- New needles for your sewing machine or serger * ✓

*You may want to wait to purchase needles for your sewing machine as we will base that choice on your fabric.

** Your first skirt will be a fitting garment, so we will baste the skirt, perfect the fit and determine if you need darts or not. Once the pattern is fitted, you may serge future skirts and skip the fitting process.
